









Company Profile

Costamare Inc. is one of the world's leading owners and providers of containerships and dry bulk vessels for charter. The Company has 50 years of history in the international shipping industry and a fleet of 68 containerships, with a total capacity of approximately 513,000 TEU and 39 dry bulk vessels with a total capacity of approximately 2,900,000 DWT (including one vessel that we have agreed to sell and two vessels we have agreed to acquire). The Company also has a dry bulk operating platform, Costamare Bulkers Inc. ("CBI"), which charters in/out dry bulk vessels, enters into contracts of affreightment, forward freight agreements and may also utilize hedging solutions. CBI operates a fleet of 54 dry bulk vessels of approximately 8,149,000 DWT, which are chartered-in under period time-charters. The Company participates in a leasing business that provides financing to third party owners.


